LOCATION GETTING TO AWAJI ISLAND

Awaji Island is 110 minutes by airport limousine from Kansai Airport. As soon as you cross the world's longest Akashi Kaikyo Bridge, you arrive at the Awaji Interchange, the gateway to the new resort zone on the west coast of Awaji Island.

Adjacent to the Awaji Interchange, is the Hyogo Prefectural Awajishima Park, which covers 134 hectares and is home to anime park Nijigen no Mori.

A loop bus is available between Awaji IC and the 11 restaurants and attractions along the West Coast. This is Av




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GOURMET PLAN

THEATER & RESTAURANT

Overlooking the ocean, Seikaiha features the Naminoritei theater, presenting Japanese culture through Japanese music and performance, Aonoya, a social distancing restaurant serving Japanese cusine made with local Awaji ingredients, Uminoya, a classic Western style restaurant, and Koshunoya, Japan's first aged sake bar serving carefully selected sake aged for a period 10 years or more.

Seikaiha joined the lineup of facilities along the west coast in 2020 and presents a mix Japanese food, Western food, Italian food, Chinese food, steak and gourmet food from all over the world.

Seaside Restaurant and Market

Dine and shop in this playful resort atmosphere while enjoying the view of Awaji Island's sea and a sunset selected as one of the 100 best in Japan.

Craft Circus features three areas for guests to "eat", "shop" and "have fun".

Awaji Kaiou Ichiba offers casual dining with freshly caught fish and seafood, such as sashimi and nigirizushi, prepared on the spot from two 4-meter long fish tanks, in which fish from the Seto Inland Sea are displayed.

The market sells vegetables harvested on the day, popular souvenirs from Awaji Island, and other products from affiliated companies.

Nojima Scola


Renovation of a closed-down school

ANIME PARK



Nijigen no Mori is located by the Awaji Interchange, amidst the nature of Hyogo Prefectural Awajishima Park, which covers a span of 134 hectares.

The attractions of Nijigen no Mori include Godzilla Interception Operation Awaji, Naruto & Boruto Shinobizato, Crayon Shin-chan Adventure Park and the Hi no Tori Night Walk.


THEATER RESTAURANT


GRAND CHARIOT LUXURY VILLA RESORT
